PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The success of our program depends upon the work of many employees. This includes part-time employees such as, field supervisors and umpires. There are also various full-time employees who work throughout the year on various aspects of the program.

The United States Specialty Sports Association (USSSA) sanctions all slowpitch softball played within the City's program.

During the calendar year, there are 4 separate seasons depending on the weather and make-up games throughout the year:

Session 1 - January thru March	(regular)
Session 2 - April thru June	(regular)
Session 3 - July thru September	(regular)
Session 4 - October thru November	(one-pitch)

Sessions 1-3 usually last 8 weeks. Session 4 takes up any remaining available time.

Playoffs are available for Sessions 1-3. After Session 4, or on the 1st weekend of December, is the "King of the Hill" City Championship Tournament.

This tournament concludes the program's activities for the year. It is played under the one-pitch format.

Fees include:

League entry - Depends on number of games

Playoffs fee - \$30

USSSA registration - \$20 one time yearly charge, expires 11/30

Umpire fees - Paid on the field, each game

Forms include:

Player contract - All players wishing to participate in the City's program, must complete a Player contract. Contracts are good for a 3-year period from date of submission. Each player will then be issued a contract number.

Roster - Each team coach must submit a team roster. Before, a coach can submit a roster; all players must have submitted their player contract.

Coaches Agreement - In order to coach a team in the City's program, each team coach/manager must submit a Coaches Agreement.

Add/Delete - This form is used only for changes to an already submitted valid roster.

All player contracts, rosters and coaches agreements must be completed prior to the coaches meeting for that session. All of the above forms are submitted through www.elpasosoftball.com.

Coaches meetings occur the week prior to the start of the season. Each coach is required to attend the meeting. Any team that does not have someone in attendance will not be allowed to lodge any sort of protest throughout the season; and also could be replaced with a team on the waiting list.

Types of coaches meetings:

Sit down - All teams in Session 1. After session 1, any team that has not already played in the calendar year; any team with a new coach; any team that has not fulfilled their requirement, must attend.

Walk in - Any team with the same coach, which played the previous season during current calendar year and attended a sit down meeting sometime during the same calendar year.
